

Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC) Quality Incentive Program

General Information on the CCBHC Quality Incentive Program (QIP)

The CCBHC QIP represents a pay for-performance program for Minnesota's public behavioral health care system. CCBHCs are eligible for a quality incentive payment based on reaching specific numeric thresholds on performance metrics identified by DHS. These quality incentive payments are in addition to payments made under the daily bundled payment rate. Eligible providers receive payment 12 months after the measurement year.

CCBHCs must meet targets and minimum thresholds on 6 measures to qualify for a bonus payment. In order to make thresholds fair and attainable, performance thresholds will be capped at 95%. This means, clinics will be considered to have met performance expectations on a measure at 95%. Please see the CCBHC Evaluation Manual for more information on measure specifications.

DHS will publish quality measures and numeric thresholds on the <u>CCBHC website</u>, as well as notify each CCBHC of the criteria for receiving an incentive payment in writing, prior to the start of the measurement year. CCBHCs will provide preliminary data mid-year and be notified of their final performance on the QIP measures by the 12th month following the end of each measurement year.

At the time of the original publication of the benchmarks for Calendar Year 2022, 6 clinics were operating under the Section 223 Federal Demonstration and all other clinics were operating under Minnesota's State Plan Amendment (SPA). Clinics who were part of the demonstration operated under a fiscal year measurement year, known as the demonstration year. Clinics who were part of the SPA operated under a calendar year measurement year. Benchmarks for clinics operating under the demonstration during this overlapping period of time are available under the document "Demo Clinic Benchmarks DY4 and DY5".

Calendar Year 2022 (CY22) runs from January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022.

Updated CY22 Benchmarks

Tables 2 to 7. CY22 Benchmarks for State Plan Amendment (SPA) Clinics

Calendar Year 2022 (CY22) January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2022

For Human Development Center and Western Mental Health Center, benchmarks for CY22 were calculated using the average of CY19 and CY20 results for HEDIS measures plus one percentage point. For clinic-led measures for these two clinics, benchmarks were calculated by using the average of CY21 and CY22 data. In this updated document, only clinic-led measure benchmarks were updated for Human Development Center and Western Mental Health Center.

For Central MN Mental Health Center, Hiawatha Valley Mental Health Center, South Central Human Relations Center, and Woodland Centers benchmarks for CY22 were calculated using the average of CY20 and CY21 results for HEDIS measures. For clinic-led measures, clinics will successfully submit their clinic-led data to qualify for a bonus payment. In this updated document, benchmarks were created once claims data became available to calculate state-led HEDIS measures for the above, new clinics.

Performance thresholds will be capped at 95%. Once clinic-led data is submitted, CY22 benchmarks will be calculated and updated. Currently, CY22 an asterisk placeholder is in place of the benchmarks for clinic-led measures.
