

Approved Early Childhood and School Age Related Training for Child Care Center Staff Qualification Variances

Early childhood and school age related training from the following organizations will automatically be considered for approval related to staff qualification variance requests. In addition, when a professional development plan is required to demonstrate how the subject of a variance request will gain additional education or training, early childhood and school age related training from these organizations may be required as a condition of approval of the varianceⁱ.
