Question	Answer

If opening an additional IOP site, and are already enrolled at a different location, do we need to submit another full application?	Yes, if you open a new location you will need to submit a new application. The application can use the same policies and procedures as previous applications.
What program was the only 3.3?	Vinland National Center is the only 3.3 Clinically Managed Population Specific High-Intensity Residential Services in Minnesota.
Am I correct in assuming that if we are already licensed under 245G and 245.20 we do not need to take additional action on those points, correct?	Yes, the first step for outpatient and residential providers is obtaining the MN 245G.20 Specializing in the Treatment. If your program has the designation then you may begin working with the 1115 Team on the Demonstration requirements.
Can we bundle "like" programs under one application? Or should each program have their own application?	Yes, programs with the same or very similar policies and procedures maybe use one application. If the policies and procedures differ significantly, then submit two applications. This will expedite the review process.
