Reminder: Response needed by April 30, 2017

Dear home and community-based services (HCBS) adult day and customized living providers:

If you provide services to people whose services are funded by a waiver – Alternative Care (AC), Brain Injury (BI), Community Alternative Care (CAC), Community Access for Disability Inclusion (CADI), Developmental Disabilities (DD) or Elderly Waiver (EW) – you must complete an <u>online provider</u> <u>attestation (DHS-7176) (PDF)</u> by April 30, 2017.

You will be able to log back into your attestation form and continue to update the status of each service standard until all are marked compliant until Sept. 1, 2017. However, your initial attestation response is due April 30.
