Costs associated with moving

- Back payment of utility bills to ensure housing
- Bridging appointment fee
- Cleaning supplies
- Connection fees for utilities
- Cost of securing documentation that is required to obtain a lease on an apartment or home
- Garbage bags

- Moving boxes and moving tape
- Movers, moving vehicle
- One storage claim per year submitted one time for up to 90 days
- One-time pest control treatment
- One-time storage release fee to remove items to take to the person's home

Items NOT covered by Housing Stabilization Services - Transition Moving Expenses

- Clothing: all garments
- Food: perishable and non-perishable items
- Recreational items such as computers (desktops and laptops), cell phones, monthly cell phone payments, and back payments
- Rent and mortgage payments
