Child Care Services Division Updates

1) Active Supervision Courses (8)

- Under revision by contractor with FCC experience
- Participant evaluations and trainer/delivery system feedback informed
- Raising the level of three courses

2) Health and Safety Courses (7) (Center, FCC, LNL)

- Under revision by contractors with FCC/Center/LNL experience
- Participant evaluations and trainer/delivery system feedback informed
- Aligning content across versions and piloting trainer help document

3) Translated four additional courses to Somali and Spanish

Active Supervision Course Expansion

- Ongoing biannual review of independently owned courses
- Licensing and CDS staff review content for requirements
- New courses designated in Develop with “Active Supervision”

Child Care Aware Annual PD survey (1 of 2)

In 2023 CCA completed their annual PD statewide survey

- Training preferences
- Training delivery needs
- Minnesota's Knowledge and Competency Frameworks (KCF's) for Early Childhood Professionals- gaps in training
- Language and ADA Accommodation
- CCA Customer Service
- Other CCA Professional Development Service Usage

735 of the 1,108 respondents identified as FCC providers

Child Care Aware Annual PD survey (2 of 2)

Highlights of Survey Findings:

- ✓ Adequate supply of online and face-to-face training events in all KCF areas to meet demand and no significant gaps identified for training events in specific KCF areas.
- ✓ Educators can navigate Develop to find training events that they want and need to satisfy personal interests and Parent Aware, CDA, and licensing requirements.
- ✓ Tailored trainings, Super Saturday training events and partnering with local associations are meeting the demand.
- ✓ More work is needed to engage providers in other languages and improve ADA accommodations.
