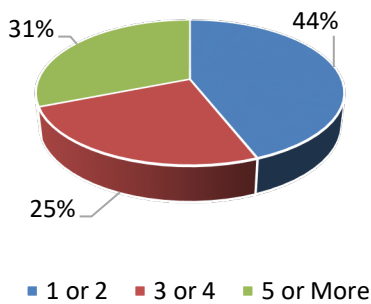

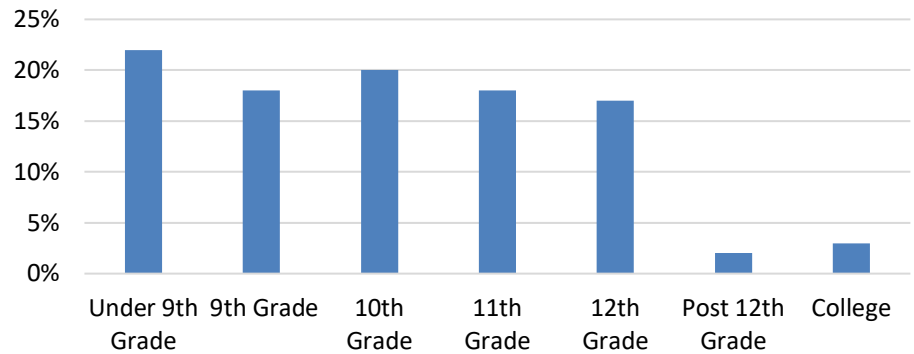

Number of services received (FY21)

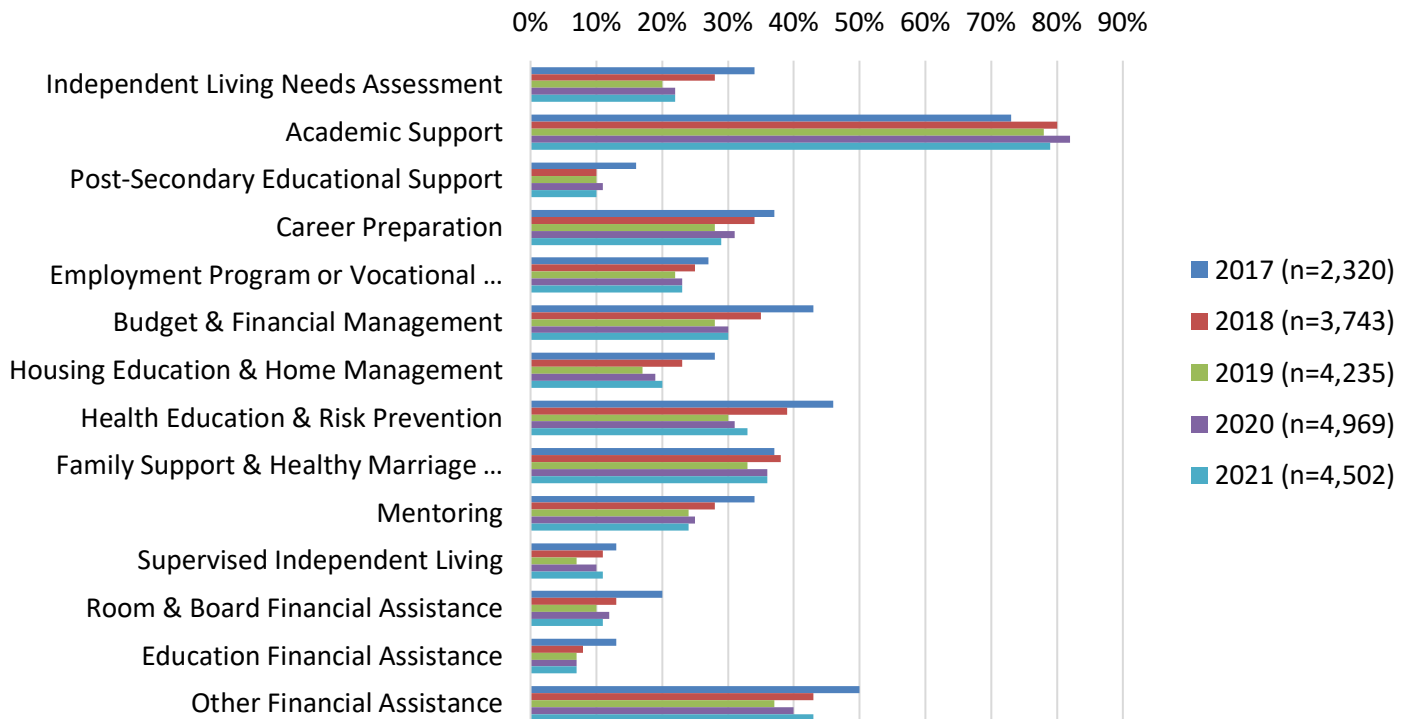


Education level of youth receiving services (FY 21)

Percent of youth receiving each service (of total youth served)

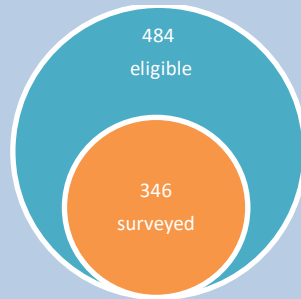

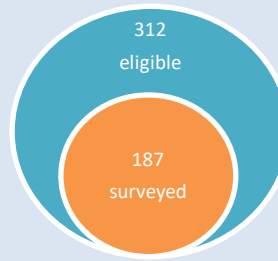
Cohort 3 survey participation, FY 17-21

(17 year-olds in foster care, FY 17)



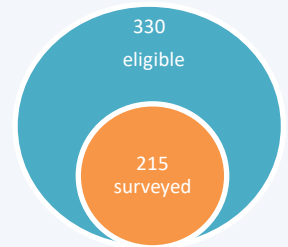
