Introduce Mike Evans; Mike share; Q & A from panel members	<ul> <li>FOSTER ONE: Was birthed from the need for support for foster parents</li> <li>Initially created a support group that grew to Foster One</li> <li>Support Foster parents, guardians, kinship, bio parents</li> <li>Created a class for parenting</li> <li>Each parent has a parent advocate that provides mentorship, transportation to class</li> <li>7 weeks of classes that helps them gain confidence, reunification and prevention</li> <li>The class is recognized by courts for court ordered parenting classes</li> <li>Question from Bae:         <ul> <li>what is the demographics of those attending?</li> <li>50/50 between foster family and kinship family support group is major Caucasian 70/30</li> <li>Parenting is 50/50 white to black participants</li> <li>Xmas event is majority African American</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

Jill Esch, State Ombudsperson – updates	<ul> <li>Ombudsperson role is to make sure the county is in compliance with kids in OHP</li> <li>On March 16th 2023 governor Walz signed into law a codifying bill for ICWA into the Child Welfare Act</li> <li>We do not know what the MN SC will do regarding finding ICWA unconstitutional</li> <li>Hennepin County should highlight the work at the national conference</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>There are 11 tribal nations in MN - Jill can work on a case if the case is in a MN county court regardless where the tribe is from</li> <li>Hennepin does a good job in making sure the family is providing family with resources</li> <li>We need to educate families on how to stick to the case plan so they reunite faster</li> <li>In MN the population for native families is under 2% but in the child welfare system they represent 20%</li> <li>Jill will find out more about the changes made in San Diego county that reduced native cases by a huge amount</li> <li><u>https://cncfr.jbsinternational.com/aunties</u></li> </ul>
