 - point of entry to a range of services for anyone in the community.
 - FRCs provide information, assess needs, make referrals to family services, and provide direct delivery of family services by FRC staff or contracted providers.
 - FRCs are welcoming and strengths-based and are designed to meet the needs, cultures, and interests of the communities served. Families and family advocates
 - work in partnership to develop and pursue families' goals in increasing self-reliance and self-sufficiency. There are myriad organizations and efforts that provide important resources and connection for families, such as food banks or co-op preschools, that are complementary but distinct from the

- Family Resource Center model. (Def: Washington State) - the building we lease in Bloomington could be useful.
