- work in partnership to develop and pursue families' goals in increasing self-reliance and selfsufficiency. There are myriad organizations and efforts that provide important resources and connection for families, such as food banks or coop preschools, that are complementary but distinct from the

 Family Resource Center model. (Def: Washington State) - the building we lease in Bloomington could be useful.
