



## Payment for successful federal district court outcomes

The Minnesota Department of Human Services will pay contracted Social Security Advocacy Services grantees \$4000.00 per individual when there is a successful federal district court outcome and you represented the individual at both their hearing before an administrative law judge and at their Appeals Council review on their initial application/claim. While your contract does not specifically reference work performed or paid at the federal district court level, our attorney supports current contract language found in section 2.4.5. Appeals Council Review, sufficient to allow DHS to pay grantees for successful federal district court outcomes. Therefore, current contracts do not need to be amended to include specific work performed and payments issued for successful federal district court outcomes.

Additionally, please note that grantees must waive ALL fees (see contract sections 2.4.1.B; 3.2.d.5; and 3.2.d.6) including EAJA (Equal Access to Justice Act) fees.


