Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS) Notice

Dear JEANINE Q PUBLIC6,

You are currently enrolled in UCare integrated Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC). You are eligible to change your health plan for January 01, 2025 as part of Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS).

If you want to keep your current health plan, do nothing with this notice. If you want to change your integrated SNBC health plan, change to non-integrated SNBC, or opt out of SNBC and keep Medical Assistance (MA) fee for service, continue reading.

If there are other members of your household enrolled in Minnesota Health Care Programs, they will receive a separate AHPS notice.

Integrated SNBC is a voluntary managed care program that combines your Medical Assistance and Medicare health benefits into one health plan. Information on your SNBC choices is as follows.

Information about your SNBC choices

You are currently enrolled in integrated Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC)

What this program does:

- You get most of your Medicare and Medical Assistance health care services through the health plan.
- There is more coordination between doctors, hospitals and other health care workers through a care coordinator.
- You get extra services that are not available through regular Medical Assistance.
- There are no additional costs for enrolling.
- **If you want to keep your current plan, you do not need to do anything.**
- **If you want to change integrated SNBC health plans you will need to complete a separate enrollment form and return it to the health plan by December 02, 2024. Use the health plan contact information in this letter to contact a health plan that is available to you and request an enrollment form.**

You have other choices:

Enroll in non-integrated Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC)

What is non-integrated SNBC?

- You would get Medicare Parts A and B services through Original Medicare and prescription drugs through a separate Medicare Part D plan.
- You would still receive a care coordinator.
- Enrollment is voluntary. You can disenroll or switch to a different plan each month.

If you want to disenroll from your current integrated SNBC health plan, contact the Senior LinkAge Line at 800-333-2433 (this call is free) to choose a Medicare Part D plan by December 02, 2024.

Opt out of SNBC and get your Medical Assistance as fee for service

What is fee for service?

- You would get Medicare Parts A and B services through Original Medicare and prescription drugs through a separate Medicare Part D plan.
- You can opt out of SNBC and get your Medical Assistance as fee for service at any time.

If you want to return to MA fee for service, contact Senior LinkAge Line at 800-333-2433 (this call is free) to pick a new Medicare Part D plan.

How do I decide what SNBC health plan is right for me?

- Call Disability Hub MN™ at 866-333-2466, go to disabilityhubmn.org, or call using your preferred relay service to assist you in reviewing your current benefits and comparing your options.
- Disability Hub MN™ can help you change plans.

Note: When considering a health plan, you may want to ask your providers if they are part of the health plan. Or you can refer to the health plan provider directories and other resources on the AHPS website at: <https://mn.gov/dhs/health-plan-selection/>.

Reminder: If you would like to switch Integrated SNBC health plans you must contact the health plan you would like for January 01 and request an enrollment form. You need to return that enrollment form to the health plan by December 02, 2024.
