

Certified Community Behavioral Health Center Certification Prerequisite Requirements

- Verify the CCBHC conforms to at least one of the following statutorily established criteria:
 - Is a non-profit organization, exempt from tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code; Is part of a local government behavioral health authority;
 - Is operated under the authority of the Indian Health Service, an Indian tribe, or tribal organization pursuant to a contract, grant, cooperative agreement, or compact with the Indian Health Service pursuant to the Indian Self-Determination Act (25 U.S.C. 450 et seq.);
 - Is an urban Indian organization pursuant to a grant or contract with the Indian Health Service under Title V of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.).
- Certified as mental health clinics under section [245.69, subdivision 2](#);
- Licensed to provide substance use disorder treatment according to [state standards](#) for adults and children.
- Certified to provide children's therapeutic services and supports according to [state standards](#);
- Certified to provide adult rehabilitative mental health services according to [state standards](#);
- Enrolled to provide mental health crisis response services according to state standards for [adults](#) and [children](#);
- Enrolled to provide [adult and children's mental health targeted case management](#);
- Enrolled to provide [certified peer specialist services](#), [certified family peer specialist services](#) and [certified peer recovery services](#) according to state standards
- Attend DHS sponsored CCBHC Orientation
