## Minnesota Substance Use Disorder Community of Practice Meeting Overview

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The Substance Use Disorder (SUD) Community of Practice (CoP) consists of people who are engaged in the field of SUD treatment and prevention in any capacity including, but not limited to, people with lived experience, providers, family members, researchers, recovery peers, state agency and county health and human service representatives, health plan representatives and advocates. The group will issue reports and recommendations to the legislative chairs and ranking minorities of committees in both local and regional governments.

During the first part of the CoP, presenters will summarize previous discussions on understanding the 4<sup>th</sup> edition American Society for Addiction Medicine's (ASAM) levels of care and allow participants to provide additional input on the topic. Participants will then hear from the Latricia Tate, CEO and Co-founder of Twin Cities Recovery Project on their organization's efforts in Minnesota. Finally, participants will begin a two-part discussion on providing culturally competent care, led by our community consultant and Founder/CEO of Motivational Consulting, George Lewis.
