## Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS) Notice

You are currently enrolled in MEDICA non-integrated Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC). You are eligible to change your health plan for January 01, 2024 as part of Annual Health Plan Selection (AHPS). If you want to keep your current health plan, do nothing with this notice. If you want to change your non-integrated SNBC health plan, change to integrated SNBC, or opt out of SNBC and keep Medical Assistance (MA) fee for service, continue reading.

Non-integrated SNBC is a voluntary managed care program. You receive your Medical Assistance benefits through a health plan separate from your Medicare benefits. Information on your SNBC choices is as follows.

If there are other members of your household enrolled in Minnesota Health Care Programs, they will receive a separate AHPS Notice.

You are currently enrolled in non-integrated Special Needs BasicCare

What this program does:

- You get Medicare Parts A and B services through Original Medicare and prescription drugs through a separate Medicare Part D plan.
- You still receive a care coordinator.
- Enrollment is voluntary. You can disensell or switch to a different plan each month.
- If you want to keep your current plan and it is still available, you do not need to do anything.
- If you want to choose a different non-integrated SNBC health plan, respond to this notice by December 01, 2023. You can respond by returning this notice in the enclosed envelope, by calling Disability Hub MN™ at 866-333-2466, by going to disability hubmn.org, or using your preferred relay service. Integrated Special Needs BasicCare (SNBC) What is Integrated SNBC?

You would get most of your Medicare and Medical Assistance health care services through the health

- There is more coordination between doctors, hospitals and other health care workers through a care coordinator.
- You would get extra services that are not available through regular Medical Assistance.
- There are no additional costs for enrolling.

#### Opt out of SNBC get your Medical Assistance as fee for service What is fee for service?

- You would get Medicare Parts A and B services through Original Medicare and prescription drugs through a separate Medicare Part D plan.
- You can opt out of SNBC and get your Medical Assistance as fee for service at any time.
- If you want to return to MA fee for service, contact Disability Hub MN™ at 866-333-2466, or call using your preferred relay service to go to fee for service by December 01, 2023.
