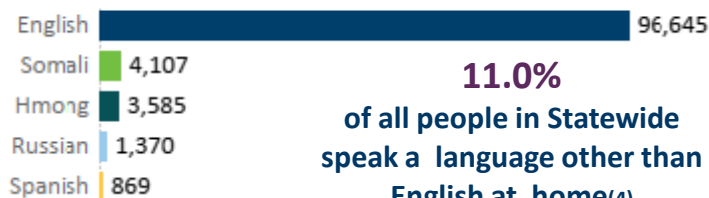

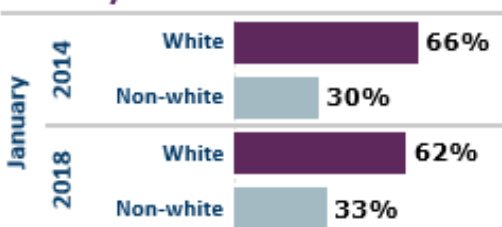

Home and Community-based Services⁽⁶⁾: Change over time (January 2014 vs. January 2018)

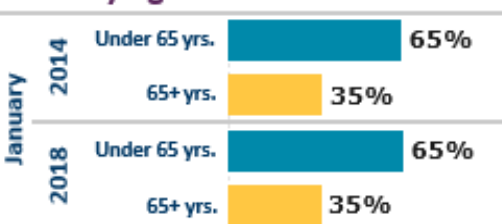

HCBS by Age

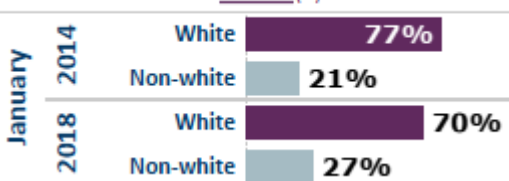

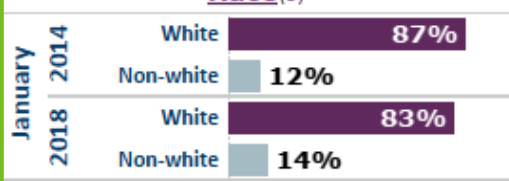

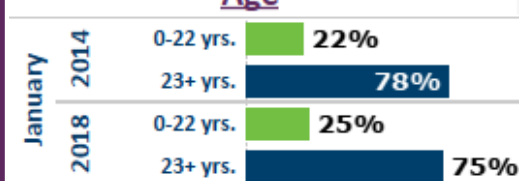

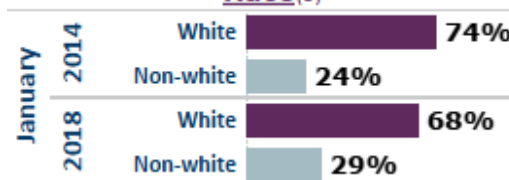

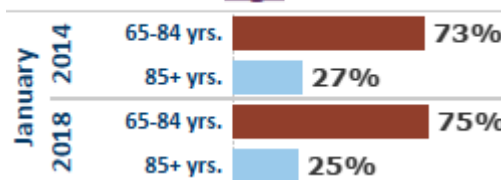

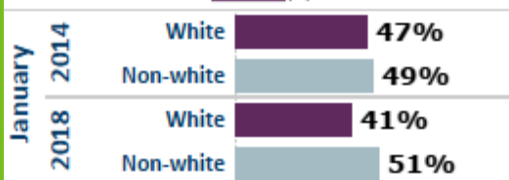

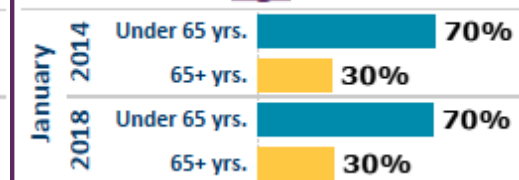
